One of the most important Parky features is our revolutionary **Woodshield**. This ultra-strong, invisible technology is the **ultimate protection** for your wooden floors.

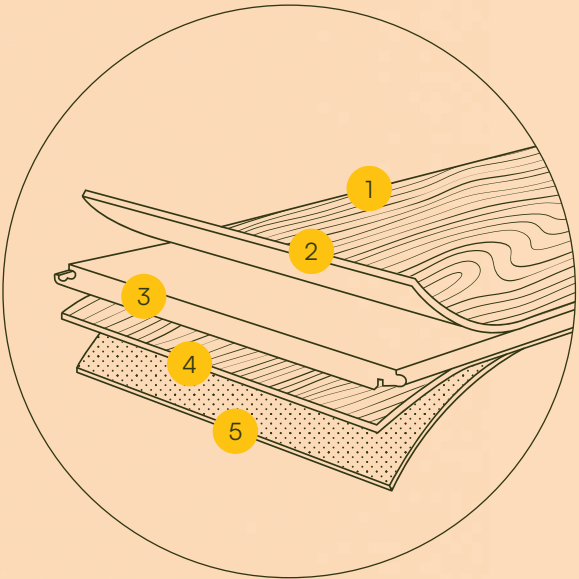
Woodshield comprises **eight strong layers of lacquer**, which make our Parky floors highly wear-resistant and scratchproof. This specially developed, matt lacquer follows the grain of our brushed floors very closely, resulting in a **superb appearance**. No need to compromise on the natural charm of wood with these exceptionally strong floors.

But Woodshield protects more than just the wood grain. It also protects the V-grooves between the planks, creating a **waterproof** surface that can withstand water for at least **24 hours**. In other words, your floor is fully protected against water, dirt and dust, right into the deepest corners.

Did you happen to drop a vase, glass or something else? No need to panic: Woodshield **also protects Parky floors against dents**. The reinforced finish, the real wood top layer and robust high-density fibreboard (HDF) at the core of each plank create a **rock solid trio**.

The carefully designed structure and the reinforced protection for our Parky floors ensure **long-term quality, carefree use and low maintenance**, even when subjected to intensive or commercial use (class 33).

- BACKING LAYER ⁴**
Below the high-density fibreboard, a robust wooden backing layer ensures **equal stability**.
- CORK LAYER ⁵**
The Deluxe+ collection integrates an environmentally-friendly cork underlay, with an **easy installation** and a **softer footfall sound** as a result.

A SUSTAINABLE CHOICE

At Parky, we hold a deep respect for nature and take a conscientious approach when using raw materials. That's why you won't find any solid wood planks in our collections. Parky floors are designed with care, only using a **thin wood top layer**. This means **25x less wood is required** compared to the production of solid parquet. Our wood originates from well-managed forests and is PEFC-certified. Combined with an HDF core made from 100% recovered wood, this results in a sustainable product that is much stronger and more stable than traditional solid wood parquet.

Furthermore, our Parky floors are finished with exclusively water-based wood stains, adhesives with a minimum of volatile organic compounds, and lacquer with a low concentration of solvents. The result is **an excellent air quality** with all Parky floors holding an **A+ quality label**.

We generate our own **renewable energy** which supplies 25% of our needs for the Parky production process and are working towards achieving a **positive carbon footprint** by 2040. It is our ambition to give back more to the earth than to take from it.

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DECOSPAN PARKY LIMITED WARRANTY

Parky is a quality made product. Decospan NV's ("Decospan") quality standards are backed by the following warranty terms and conditions.

Warranty Terms and Conditions

1. This warranty covers only the original owner (hereinafter referred to as "You" or the "Purchaser") and first installation at the premises of an end-user consumer buyer.
2. Parky floor is a wood veneered floor manufactured by Decospan (hereinafter referred to as the 'Product').
3. The warranty starts at the date of the delivery of the Product at the installation site. In case the Products are incorrectly stored, between the delivery of the Products at the storage location, at the distributor or retail location, this warranty is void and the party where the Products were wrongly stored shall be held responsible.
4. The term of the warranty can be either 5, 10, 15 years or more. The term depends on the Product range and the type of use (domestic, low-commercial, commercial) and is pointed out in the technical specifications of the Product. (see: 'warranty'). **Only the term indicated in the technical specifications of the Products, valid at the moment of the delivery of the Product,** is the correct warranty term.
5. Decospan will either repair or replace a defective Product according to its choice. In case replacement is decided, only products from Decospan's current product portfolio, matching as closely as possible the warranted Products, will be available. No other form of compensation or damages will be provided. The warranty does never cover any labour cost associated with removal or replacement of Products.
6. If the repair or replacement occurs within year 1 or 2, 100% of the Product cost will be available to repair or replace the Product.
7. As from year 3, the warranty is degressive, by which the value lowers according the length of the use, along the following descending scales:

If the technical specifications point out a warranty of 5 years

Year 3	75%
Year 4	50%
Year 5	25%

If the technical specifications point out a warranty of 10 years

Year 3-4	80%
Year 5-6	60%
Year 7-8	40%
Year 9-10	20%

If the technical specifications point out a warranty of 15 years

Year 3-5	80%
Year 6-8	60%
Year 9-11	40%
Year 12-14	20%
Year 15	10%

If the technical specifications point out a longer warranty or a limited lifetime warranty

Year 3-10	80%
Year 11-15	40%
Year 15-20	20%
Beyond 20	10%

8. Decospan may contract with Purchaser to perform any repairs hereunder, or Decospan may at its own discretion, utilize a third party. The Purchaser will be responsible for any portion of the repair or replacement cost. Costs for removing or replacing the Product are not covered hereunder unless Decospan elects to provide repairs. Incidental costs of repair such as, but not limited to moving furniture or removal and reinstallation of cabinets or the like are not covered hereunder. The period of the original warranty is not extended by any repair or replacement of the Product.
9. This warranty applies worldwide.
10. Decospan does not offer any warranties except those written in this document.

TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, THERE ARE NO IMPLIED OR OTHER WARRANTIES BEYOND THIS EXPRESSED LIMITED WARRANTY. ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, INCLUDING IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, ARE EXCLUDED. DECOSPAN EXCLUDES ANY LIABILITY FOR LOST PROFITS OR ANY OTHER INDIRECT, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, EVEN IF DECOSPAN HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES. THE REMEDIES CONTAINED HEREIN ARE THE ONLY REMEDIES AVAILABLE FOR BREACH OF THIS LIMITED WARRANTY. THE LIMITATIONS AND EXCLUSIONS STATED HEREIN MAY BE LIMITED OR MODIFIED BY ANY APPLICABLE NATIONAL LEGISLATION OR BY YOUR STATE LAW, IN WHICH CASE SUCH NATIONAL LEGISLATION OR STATE LAW SHALL GOVERN.

11. Warranty Claims – If the Purchaser, has a warranty claim, please notify the Product defect within 30 days of detection of this defect by registered letter (with return receipt) sent to:

Decospan will work with You to promptly effect any warranted repairs or replacement hereunder. You must retain and provide a copy of your purchase documentation, the product reference, and the first consumer sale documentation for any warranty claim hereunder.

12. WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS – The following are not covered by the Product warranty:

- **Visible defects:** that are installed in the floor: floorboards with visible defects should not be installed and once installed are no longer covered by this warranty. In the case of any defect being detected, You must notify Decospan in writing within 30 days of receipt of the Product, accompanied by a copy of your purchase invoice. In the case of any defect being detected, Decospan will provide a replacement at no cost to you as soon as reasonably possible.
 - **Damage by misuse or poor maintenance:** The Product must be installed and maintained according to the Parky installation and maintenance instructions using the approved Parky underlays and maintenance products. Proof may be required that maintenance and installation have been done according to these Parky instructions and that the end user consumer has been advised by You of these instructions. Instructions can be found on the website www.par-ky.com and/or at your dealership.
 - **Normal wear and tear:** Each lacquered wood floor following Industry Standards is subject to normal wear and tear. Wear and tear resulting from failure to observe Industry Standards for maintenance and useful recommendations by Decospan, are hereby excluded from this warranty. The following is only a partial exemplary list of Parky recommended use and maintenance procedures. For a complete list, we refer to the Industry Standards (for the U.S.: www.nwfa.org; for Europe and all other countries: www.parquet.net). Flooring can be cleaned with a slightly damp cloth, you should avoid excessive water and the floor must be dried after cleaning. Flooring should not be cleaned by steam cleaners, carpet cleaners, polishes or any liquid cleaners not specifically approved by Decospan. Legs of furniture should be equipped with adequate protection material. Chairs or furniture on wheels must be equipped with soft wheels. A protective mat should be provided to offer protection under office chairs. Use of a vacuum cleaner with a beater bar head will damage the flooring, which damage is excluded from this limited warranty. Adequate protection at entrances for cleaning shoes is essential in order to avoid sand or grit. Breathable rugs or mats should be used in high traffic areas. Damage from liquid spills, stiletto heels, animal claws or nails, dropped objects or the like is not covered by this limited warranty. Flooring installed in bathrooms or other areas subject to spills or high humidity is not covered by this limited warranty.
 - **Accidents** such as but not limited to scratches from moving heavy objects on the floor, impact damage, consequential damage, fire, natural disaster or any circumstance other than normal usage.
 - **Humidity:** mold stains, damage and deformation of floor boards due to extended and recurrent exposure to exceptionally low (below 40%) or high humidity conditions (above 60%) or inadequate ventilation.
 - **Normal color and structure variation:** wood is a natural product. There are no two identical trees and therefore each board is unique and has natural color and structure variations. Small marks such as but not limited to knots and mineral streaks are naturally occurring and have no effect on the quality of the floor.
 - **Difference between production batches:** As wood is a natural product, there will be variations. Decospan strongly advises the installer to use the same production batch per room in order to obtain the most uniform result. You can find the production number on the backing of each board and we highly recommend not mixing two different batches.
 - **Discoloration:** each wooden floor is subject to discoloration. Under the influence of sunlight the color of the wood may either darken or lighten. This is a natural process.

REPAIR PENS

Instructions for use

CONTENT

A box contains 2 pens to achieve the best results for touching up small scratches in your Parky floor:

- 1 pen with pigmented lacquer (pigmented lacquer pen 240) or 1 colour marker (repair pen 210, only for Smoked Walnut PEN19)
- 1 pen with transparent lacquer to protect and restore shine (pigmented lacquer pen 240 - PENSM)

RECOGNISING AND USING THE REPAIR PENS

Colour marker: identified by its coloured felt tip. The tip is flat and has an oblique angle, allowing for both fine and wide lines. The pen is ready to use, no preparation needed. Draw smoothly and without applying pressure. Do not hold the marker still on one spot, as this will create a dark area. Wipe away excess ink immediately with a cloth or finger.

Lacquer pen: this pen has a rounded, uncoloured tip. The lacquer pen is not ready for use; first, lacquer must be pumped into the tip. Start by shaking the pen well (you will hear the mixing ball click). Place the tip of the pen on an old piece of cardboard or plastic and pump by pressing the tip a few times. Then, hold the tip down for about ten seconds and repeat the pumping. Continue until the tip of the pen is saturated with lacquer. First, try drawing a full line on an inconspicuous area or a scrap piece before working on the damaged spot. Press the pen lightly while drawing and try to move smoothly and continuously. Do not wipe! Let it dry for 30 minutes before evaluating the result or making further touch-ups.

HOW TO TOUCH UP?

Before touching up, the damaged area must be cleaned, and any loose fibers must be removed. This can be done with a lint-free cloth.

Step 1: recolouring

The first step is to restore the colour. Scratches leave a white edge and can penetrate through the coating to the underlying wood. Recolouring is done with the colour marker or the pen with pigmented lacquer. When colouring, it is important to work smoothly without holding the marker still on the wood, as this will cause stains. It is advisable to practice on a piece of cardboard or an old piece of parquet first.

When using the colour marker, it can be useful to wipe away excess ink immediately. Be cautious with deep scratches; if you apply too much colour, dark spots may develop in the wood. Try to touch up in several small steps.

Assess the colouring from more than 1 meter away. If satisfied, proceed to the protection step. For lighter scratches, only in the lacquer, recolouring may not always be necessary for a good result.

Step 2: protection

This step is always carried out with a transparent lacquer pen. The goal of this step is to protect the damaged area from dirt and water. The protective layer will also restore the gloss level and make the damage less visible in direct light.

Use the transparent lacquer pen as described above (shake, pump). Apply smoothly over the entire damaged area, including the edges. If there is excess, you can gently remove it with a cloth, but avoid streaks and smudges. Assess after complete drying and make additional touch-ups if needed.

LIFESPAN

The colour marker is infinitely reusable and remains effective for over 5 years, provided that the marker is immediately and carefully closed with the included cap after use.

The lacquer pen has a lifespan of 5 years in unused condition. However, after the first use, the tip will gradually harden and become difficult to use after about a year. The pen should be immediately and carefully closed with the included cap after use.

SAFETY

- Safety data sheets (MSDS) can be consulted or downloaded at www.par-ky.com.
- The markers are made of aluminum with a plastic cap.
- The markers contain solvents and flammable products in very small quantities. They emit a typical odor during use.

Use exclusively for touch-ups on wood.

Keep out of reach of children.

Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames, and other sources of ignition.

Do not smoke.

Use only in a well-ventilated area.

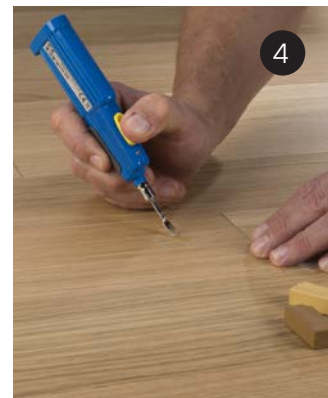
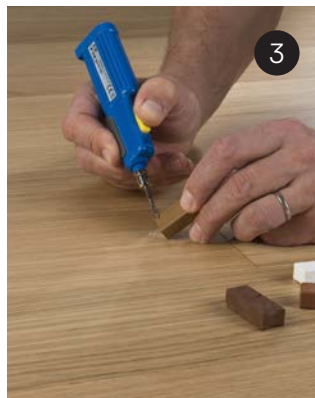
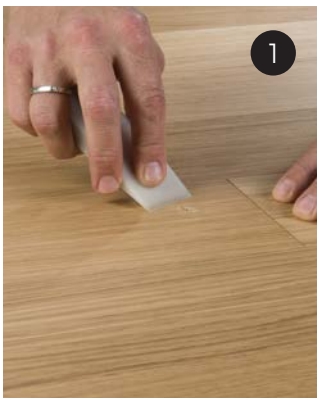
CONTENT

- 7 wax blocks
- 1 melter
- 1 scraper/cleaning comb
- 1 green/white pad
- 1 grey sanding pad

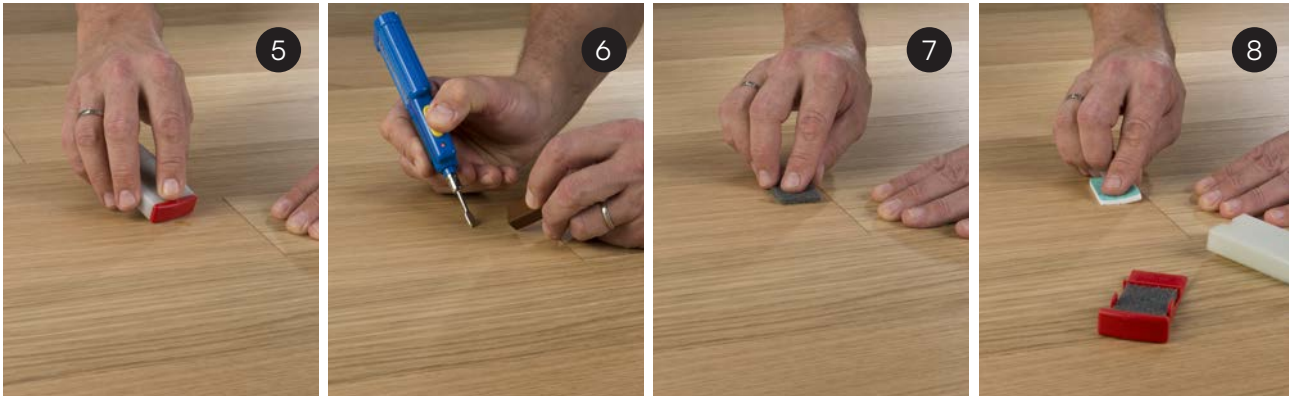


INSTRUCTIONS

1. **PREPARING:** The area to be repaired has to be clean, dry and free from grease. If necessary, remove any loose or sticking out particles with a pointed item.
2. **CHOOSE COLOURS:** Choose colours according to the indications in the colour chart (see www.par-ky.com or www.cabbani.com). Begin with the 'starter colour' and mix in further (usually darker) colours.
3. **MELTING AND MIXING:** Activate the melter by removing the protective cap, sliding the yellow button to 'ON' and pressing the blue button (10 to 15 seconds). Ensure that the tip is fitted correctly. A red light indicates that the melter is heating up. Melt off small portions of the colour sticks and mix together. Should the hard wax start smoking during melting, release the blue button. Tip cools slowly. Do not touch the tip during operation. The melter has a heat capacity of 30 minutes when operated permanently. However it is recommended to work at shorter intervals and to switch off tool from time to time.
4. **FILLING:** Let wax mixture flow into the damaged area. Always slightly overfill the area!



5. **LEVELLING:** Use the sharp grooves of the scraper to strip off excess material.
6. **PRECISE ADJUSTMENT:** For precise adjustment, restore the grain pattern of the filled area by slightly scratching with a pointed item and re-fill with a darker colour stick. Level off excess material with the planer grooves of the scraper.
7. **DEGREASING:** Use the grey sanding pad to degrease the area. The gloss level of the mixture becomes matt.
8. **GLOSS LEVEL ADJUSTMENT:** The gloss level can be adjusted with the green/white pad. The green side of the cloth polishes while the white side reduces the gloss level.



CLEANING: Use the cleaning comb to clean the planer grooves. Just wipe off melting knife with a cloth after use.

STORAGE: Always store melter with cap fitted and ensure ON/OFF switch is set to OFF position. Make sure the tip has cooled down before storage. Never bring the tool into contact with water.

RECYCLING: The melter needs to be delivered to a collection point for electronic scrap to ensure optimal recycling.

ATTENTION! The melting knife heats up very quickly. Danger of burns. Cool down period is one minute. As soon as the melting knife is heated, the filling material can be liquefied.

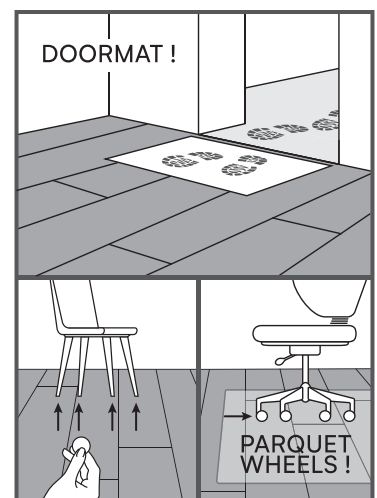
